Some of the topics discussed and resource observations made:

- 1. ATV related natural resource damage, including erosion, gullying, trail widening, dense trail network,
- 2. Garbage and dumping in boundary areas, including simple litter and one older dumping location (on north side on southerly unpaved road),
- 3. Difficult and limited capacity public access parking,
- 4. "Private" posting of an apparently Town owned & maintained road on south side,
- 5. Glacial topography and need for rerouting trails to accommodate it,
- 6. Undermining of some trees along slopes, with danger of eventual collapse,
- 7. Need for community outreach to residents in vicinity.
